Rules

3. **Each sponsor making a pledge should write their own name, pledge, and amount collected.** Participants must collect all pledges in advance.
4. On the day of the ride, the registration table at the Rahr-West Art Museum will open at 7:30am and remain open until 10:00am. Bikers may ride from the museum to the R2R rest station in Two Rivers and back, ride all the way to the Rahr Memorial School Forest and back, or they can choose to do a variation of these options.
5. Before the ride, the bikers will be given the option of attending safety training sessions at 8:00am until 10:00am. These **FREE** sessions are hosted by the Noon Optimists, Manitowoc Police Department and Holy Family Memorial Hospital at the museum. Youth riders are specifically invited to these workshops.
6. Participants are encouraged to wear hats and sunscreen if it's sunny or bring rain gear if it's rainy. Bringing a water bottle and insect repellent is recommended.
